Spjaldtölvuverkefni í Norðlingaskóla - mat kennara Niðurstöður könnunar í maí-júlí 2012 Sólveig Jakobsdóttir og Skúlína Kjartansdóttir

Könnun til kennara í þróunarverkefni um spjaldtölvur í Norðlingaskóla. Könnunin er liður í mati á vegum Rannsóknarstofu í upplýsingatækni og miðlun við Háskóla Íslands. Notuð var könnun Evrópska skólanetsis og ACER um tölvunotkun í evrópskum skólum úr stóru verkefni þar sem hver nemandi fær smátölvu í hendur og stefnt að kennslu í anda þess sem er kallað 1-1 kennslufræði ("1-1 pedagogy").
